SUBJECT: July 2024 Survey of Likely Nebraska Voters

From July 8-11, 2024 we conducted a survey of likely 2024 Nebraska voters. Deb Fischer has a commanding lead over the field in this race against relatively unknown opponents.

Generically, voters want a Republican in the Senate by a 22% margin.

Senator Fischer's record and accomplishments have given her a strong lead to start this race, which will prove very difficult for her opponents to overcome.

Methodology – The survey was conducted by Torchlight Strategies for Deb Fischer for US Senate from July 8-11, 2024. We surveyed 698 likely Nebraska voters with a mix of n=448 live calls and n=250 text-to-web surveys. The margin of error on the survey at a 95% confidence level is +/-3.7%.
